At each turn, problem cards appear on different topics that, if not resolved with the right solution cards, cause an increase in the earth's temperature. To win, everyone must play as a team. If the temperature indicator reaches the maximum level, all players lose the game!

With all the negative news about the climate crisis, families and kids are desperately seeking ways that they can be a part of the solution. These games help families learn how they can take action to create a cleaner, healthier future. By teaching kids that they can make real changes in their homes and communities, Adventerra Games prepare them to be more responsible citizens, ensuring a better quality of life for everyone.

Cooperative and competitive board games focused on how to protect the planet are appealing to all ages from elementary school to college. In the game of **PowerHaus** players find themselves in a small urban context in which they share an old house that leaks heat and wastes plenty of energy. Learn the value of clean water in this cooperative game.

Players roll dice, float down the river, and draw "Savings" or "Wasting" cards. Unlucky players must rely on the community water jug, which requires donations from players who have saved more water. If the jug is empty when someone needs it, everyone loses – so let the negotiations begin! Components: game board, 18 watersaving cards, 18 water-wasting cards, 30 question cards, 4 movement tokens, 5 water markers, 1 die, and illustrated rules. Ideal for 3 to 4 players. Play can be completed in about 30 minutes.



Recycle Rally • \$24.95 • Ages 7+

Drive recycling trucks around town and maximize your score by collecting higher-value materials. But sort carefully! If too many recyclables are left behind, useful stuff is incinerated and the whole town is in trouble. The rules also feature an advanced game mode, recommended for ages 10 and up. Components: game board, 15 playing cards, 5 recycling trucks, 1 marker disk, 3 dice, 45 objects to recycle, 10 specialized truck tokens, 1 scorecard, a sheet of color-coded recycling stickers and illustrated rules. Recycle Rally is perfect for 3 to 5 players. Game time is about 45 minutes.



PowerHaus • \$24.95 • Ages 7+

This game teaches kids they have real power to fight climate change! Players are housemates trying to reduce utility bills with energy-saving habits. As you move through the game, decide which investments in technologies are better for your wallet and the world. Components: game board, 67 game cards, 4 tokens, 4 disks, 3 dice, banknotes, and illustrated rules. Made for 3 to 4 players. Set aside an hour and learn how to save lots of energy and reduce your home electric bills.



Global Warning • \$24.95 • Ages 10+, fun for adults too!

Players work together to clean up the earth and slow climate change while the temperature rises with each turn. Can you and your friends slow it down before "Game Over" happens for you AND Planet Earth? Teamwork and up to 90 minutes of play is needed to win! Ideal for 4 to 7 players. Makes a terrific multigenerational game night. Components: game board, 87 solution cards, 57 problem cards, banknotes, 3 dice, 1 temperature indicator disk, plus illustrated rules.
